Featuring charismatic winemakers Jean-Guillaume Prats and Thomas Duroux, the seminar will include a total of eight wines ranging from the already legendary 2005 vintage back to 1985 Cos d'Estournel. In between, taste 1995 Palmer, 2000 Palmer, and 2003 Cos d'Estournel. Rounding out the selection will be each Château's second wine, Les Pagodes de Cos and Alter Ego, from the strong 2004 vintage. Do not miss this incredible opportunity to explore these two Châteaux.
